

# Murrieta education center gets donated defibrillator

The Oak Grove Center for Education, Treatment & the Arts has received an automatic external defibrillator, a life-saving device used to aid victims of cardiac arrest.

The donation comes from the Travis R. Roy Sudden Cardiac Arrest Fund, named after a middle school student who died of cardiac arrest in 2005.

Travis' father, Robert Roy, has worked to persuade area school districts to use the devices. Travis Roy, 14, was a student at a Thompson Middle School in Murrieta.
